## MINUTES Highland Park Neighborhood Coalition, October 10, 2023

The meeting was chaired by Rodney Singleton and attended by 22 people\*. A Hybrid meeting, 11 people attended in person at HYCC and 11 people joined via zoom.

## **AGENDA ITEMS**

- 1) The meeting voted to elect Lee Peters to represent Highland Park on the BPDA's Impact Advisory Group (IAG) for the development planned at 10 Malcolm X Blvd. (11 for, 0 against, 0 abstentions)
- 2) The meeting discussed the proposed change in HPNC bylaws that address how we deal with developers. No vote was taken, but the discussion addressed several issues:
  - a. It's a good idea to send developers to talk with Gabriela Amore, our staff at the Highland Park Conservation District Commission, to get an understanding of our district standards *before* embarking on development plans.
  - b. It's important to receive from the ISD what variances they have rejected and why.
  - c. A developer could produce an equivalent but informal building "worksheet", detailing these variances in advance of producing an expensive building plan.
  - d. Such a zoning map, capturing zoning within a 150' circle of each building site might also show relevant comparables adjacent to the proposed building to help discern "appropriateness" (Evan Smith offered to produce such a template).
  - e. Highland Park residents have concerns that go beyond simply the appearance of a building (under the purview of the ACDC) or the height, width and # of units (under the purview of the ISD). We also care about preventing displacement, protecting open space and creating affordable home ownership, building deeply affordable units and receiving a community benefit from each development. Where and how does THAT conversation happen?
- **3)** The meeting came up with suggestions where new members of the HPNC Steering Committee can be found: at HYCC's \$2/bag Saturdays, at the Roxbury Library, at gatherings at the First Parish Church, outside Nathan Hale School and Paige Academy, the Bolling Building, Nubian Market and Frugal Bookstore.
